# Faithful Citizenship: Forming Your Conscience for Voting

Join us on September 19 at 7 p.m. at Saint John Neumann, for a non-partisan discussion of the true meaning of "Faithful Citizenship"

Based on the USCCB's "Forming Consciences for Faithful Citizenship," and "Introductory Note for Forming Your Conscience," and Pope Francis' thoughts on "A Better Kind of Politics," St. John Neumann's Racial Justice Ministry will host a lively dialogue investigating ways to align your choice of candidate with your value system within the framework of Catholic Social Teaching. The discussion will be led by Fr. Tom Ferguson, pastor of Good Shepherd Catholic Church, Alexandria, with SJN parishioner Chris Offen assisting with the flow of questions. All are invited to join us—you bring the questions, and we will provide the refreshments! The Season of Creation spans five weeks between the **World Day** of Prayer for the Care of Creation (September 1) and the Feast Day of St. Francis of

**Assisi** (October 4). This "time for creation" offers, in the words of Pope Francis, "individual believers and communities a fitting opportunity to reaffirm their personal vocation to be stewards of creation, to thank God for the wonderful handiwork which he has entrusted to our care, and to implore his help for the protection of creation as well as his pardon for the sins committed against the world in which we live."

Below are some ways to live out these three dimensions of Pope Francis' call.

- REAFFIRM OUR VOCATION AS STEWARDS OF CREATION
   Counteract the "Throwaway Culture" In your daily life, try to
   identify the ways in which you can choose reusables, rather than
   disposables, such as coffee mugs, reusable bags, or cloth napkins,
   and commit to making one change during this month.
- 2. THANK GOD FOR HIS WONDERFUL HANDIWORK Meal Prayer Before and after meals, say a short prayer of thanksgiving for the lifegiving food that sustains and nourishes us. Briefly consider how all nourishment ultimately comes from the earth, and give thanks for all the human hands that helped bring this food to your table.
- 3. IMPLORE GOD'S HELP AND ASK HIS PARDON Confession In calling for a deep "ecological conversion," Pope Francis has emphasized the importance of examining one's own conscience, of recognizing one's sins against creation, however great or small. Seeing the interconnectedness of our world leads to an understanding that "[e]very violation of solidarity and civic friendship harms the environment."

## **Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion**

Diocese of Arlington holds Ministry Formation sessions for those wishing to become a Eucharistic Minister.

Information presented in these sessions focus on the theology of the Eucharist and your role as an Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion ("EMHC").
