S.H.A.R.E Tip Line

As a community, I know the tragedy at Apalachee High School is weighing heavy on all of our hearts and minds. While we continue to keep the Barrow County community in our thoughts, I wanted to reinforce that safety is always our top priority at Shakerag. Our teachers and staff continue to be vigilant and keep a close eye on their surroundings. We continue to ensure our building is secure and that our front office staff is closely monitoring who enters the building. In addition to our day-to-day security measures, Fulton County has worked closely with the Fulton County Schools Police Department and the Johns Creek Police Department to support our schools during this challenging time.

*Cashiers will have access to each student's gift card(s) and can apply funds directly from the register meaning that once you set up a Literati Gift Card online, students can shop without having to bring anything with them at all.
