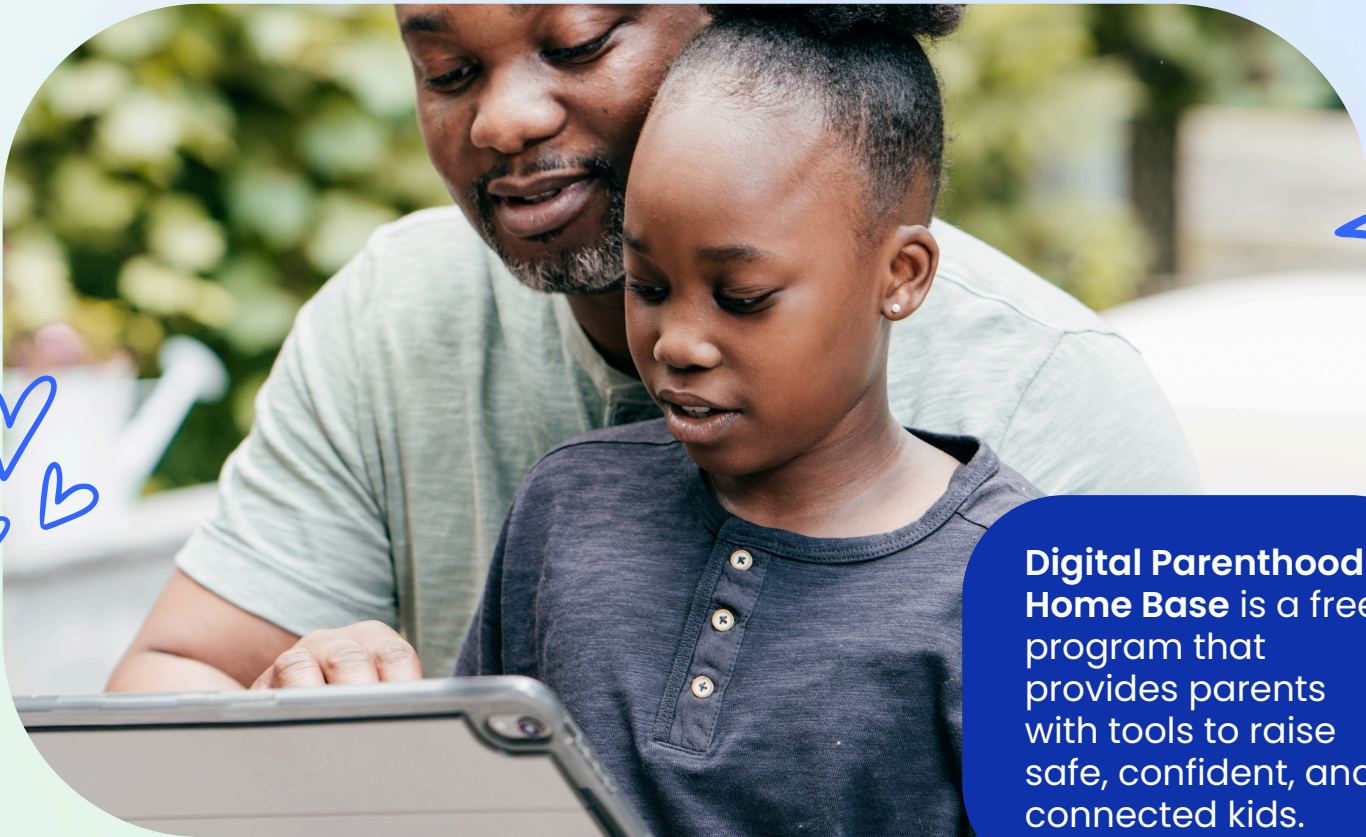


# DIGITAL PARENTHOOD HOME BASE

To participate, your school will need to designate an Online Safety Officer. The Online Safety Officer (OSO) will receive expert training so they can implement online safety best practices in their community.

## It's as easy as...

To participate, each school must have **an Online Safety Officer (OSO)** — a PTA member, teacher, or other school representative.

The OSO will join three specially-designed virtual **“train the trainer” sessions**. The first one kicks off in the fall.

Your OSO will also receive **tools and materials to support the trainings** they host for parents.
