The Academy for Community Transition (ACT) is an inclusive and comprehensive two- to three-year transition program for young adults with disabilities that prepares students for further education, employment, adult living and leisure. The ACT campus is located in three portables next door to Gibson Ek high school and also accesses the wider community for daily learning.
