



JULIUS BOEHM POOL EXPANSION - POTENTIAL COLLABORATION

OVERVIEW

Julius Boehm Pool has served residents of Issaquah since 1972. It was renovated in 2015, including reconfiguring and expanding the restroom and locker spaces, replacing mechanical system, and undertaking necessary maintenance. The pool area was upgraded but not expanded in this project. The City of Issaquah has recently obtained grant funding for the facility and has begun assessing the pool for potential expansion.

A recently completed feasibility study determined an approximately 12,500 SF expansion to the facility could house an additional 8-lane, 25-yard pool which would allow Julius Boehm Pool to support an expanded set of aquatic programs, including school swim meets. With this addition, the pool could expand its service area beyond the boundary of the City of Issaquah to the boundary of the Issaquah School District.
