APOLLO ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

OVERVIEW

Apollo Elementary School is a single-story building that was constructed in 1970 as five separate buildings connected by covered walkways. A covered play area was built in 1988. In 1995, the structure was renovated to become one building and a library and music spaces were added. Additional classrooms were built in 2013. The site currently has four portable classroom buildings housing seven classrooms. Today, Apollo is approximately 78,000 square feet in size and served 517 students in grades K-5 in the 2022-23 school year.
