PARA EDUCATOR JOB DESCRIPTION

LEARNING CENTER/LIFE SKILLS CLASSROOM

- Ability to work with students with learning disabilities, autism, emotional, physical, health, sensory, cognitive, and/or multiple impairments.
- Understand and follow individual education plans (IEP) as directed by certified teacher.
- Ability to be trained to support adaptive daily tasks such as eating, dressing, toileting. Also, may include, but not limited to, medical procedures under the guidance of the school nurse.
- Willingness to teach independent life skills (such as cooking, laundry, general personal hygiene) under the direction of the certificated teacher.
- Tutors students individually providing remedial intervention.
- Provides written materials, forms and documents for the purpose of conveying information regarding student learning activities.
- Develop materials and activities for students under the direction of the certificated teacher.
- Supervises students at recess, bus arrival and departure when needed.
- Attend relevant in services as they are available.
- Maintain confidentiality and integrity of information and records at all times.
- Provide accommodations on assessments and tests.
- Performs other duties as required or assigned which are reasonably within the scope of the duties in this job classification.
