Who is Henry?

Henry is a three and half year old Bullmastiff. He will spend most of his time (about 1-2 days a week) at Keller HS. When he is not at school, he lives with Mrs. Woodruff, her husband, their 13 year old daughter, and his fur brother Frank (a 1-year old French Bulldog).

What will Henry do at KHS?

Henry will be available for pets throughout the day in the counseling office. On Wednesdays he will sit outside the AP office with Ms. Woodruff when the counselors are monitoring the cafeteria. He will work with Mrs. Woodruff as a therapy dog to regulate emotions, lift the spirits of students and staff, and help sooth an anxious student.



What will Henry NOT do at KHS?

Henry will NOT be in the hallways during passing periods. He will NOT be in the the hallways or in the cafeteria. He will NOT go into classrooms. He will NOT provide passes to students who will be late to class.

What if a student is afraid or allergic to dogs?

Please let Mrs. Woodruff know if your student has an aversion to dogs or is allergic. Henry is bathed and brushed before coming to KHS. No student is obligated to interact with Henry.



What was Henry's Training?

While Henry prefers to take long naps, he worked hard to complete the following training at Lucky Dog Training in Keller, TX: basic manners, advanced manners, nice greets with a loose leash, and therapy dog training. Henry and Mrs. Woodruff passed the Pet Partners therapy dog test in August of 2023.
