

Attendance Policy

If your child is absent from school, please email us at AttendanceAMSO@amityregion5.org or call the attendance line at 203-392-3200, press 1 for attendance. A parent email or note must be submitted for absences 1-9 to excuse the absence. A doctor's note is required for absences 10 and greater.

Bus Stop Safety

Please see the following safety information for students riding the bus to school:

- Students crossing the road to enter the bus should not have their phone out, earbuds in, or any other distraction.
- Students should look both ways and look for a nod from the bus driver that it is safe to cross.
- The driver will not wave to the students as this may confuse motorists.
- Upon exiting the bus and crossing the road, students again should not have their phone out, earbuds in, or any other distraction before looking for a nod from the bus driver as to when it is safe to cross, looking both ways and walking in front of the bus.

Charging Devices

All students received their school devices. We appreciate your support in making sure your child charges their device every night. Charging the device as part of your child's nightly routine will ensure that your child arrives at school with access to all the educational technology used during the school day. Students should bring their device and charger to school each day.

Parent Drop off & Pick up

Although we encourage the use of the bus, if you do choose to drop off and/or pick up in the morning and at dismissal, please use the outer parking lot closest to the road.

Signs are in place in the parking lot to direct you. There are many students and staff who will be walking in the parking lot. Please drive slowly when entering or exiting. Students may be dropped off at 7:25. Students will not be allowed to enter the building before 7:25.

Water bottles in School

To be environmentally friendly and to stop the spread of germs, please encourage your child to bring a refillable water bottle to school. We have water bottle fillers available throughout the building so students can refill their bottles.

From the Nurse

To all parents who have children who may need medication in school: If you have not done so already, please obtain our medical order authorization form on the Amity website or pick it up in the nurse's office.

These orders must be completed by the pediatrician and signed by both the Dr. and guardian. This is **required** for all prescription and non-prescription medications, except Tylenol.
