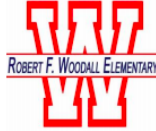

Quick Reference Sheet 2024-2025

Parents/Guardians: We are so excited to welcome our students to Woodall for the 2024-2025 school year. You can view the 2024-2025 RCS Student Handbook at www.rfwe.rcstn.net

- School Hours: 7:15am - 2:15pm
- Doors open at 6:45am. A free *Grab and Go* breakfast is available from 6:45-7:15 a.m.
- If you arrive after 7:15am, please park and sign your student in at the front office.
- Please refer to the 2024-2025 RFWE Traffic Map for instructions on entering and exiting the car rider line. Car rider tags will be required for pick-up only. Two will be provided for all students. Requests for additional tags shall be made through the front office. For the safety of all students, adults with no car tag shall park, walk to the front office, present a government issued photo ID and wait in the front office for their student after the car rider dismissal is complete.
- Student attendance is crucial. If absent, please send a note in with your child within three days of returning. (Handbook policy TC49-6-3007)
- Free and reduced lunch meal applications are available from the school nutrition program on the district website or paper copies are in the enrollment packet.
- No visitors during the instructional day. Family engagement opportunities will be available throughout the school year such as Open House, P/T Conferences, PTO meetings, book fairs, art fairs, music performances, field day, Boosterthon, field trips, and holiday parties.
- Please schedule afternoon doctor's appointments after school hours when possible. No early dismissals after 1:45pm.
- Any change in the normal mode of transportation must be in writing.
- No personal devices are allowed at school for the Pre-K through 2nd grade level.
- All medications **MUST** be brought to school by an adult. **NEVER SEND ANY MEDICATION IN A CHILD'S BACKPACK.**
