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

Drop-off and Pick-up Procedures:

Our loop is only one-way. There is no drop-off/pick-up in the back or along the side of the building or the parking lot (the back doors are locked in the mornings and students must enter through the front doors).

Student Arrival Procedures:

All students must wait in the lobby (atrium) portion of the building until 7:10 AM. There is no access to lockers prior to 7:10 AM unless prior permission is granted by a staff member.

Attendance Procedure

Please notify the school before **12:00 PM** of any student absences. There are 2 options to report any absence, or to request a late arrival or early dismissal:

Online in your **ParentVue Account** by pressing "Report Absence" next to your student's name. You may enter absences until 12:00 noon for the current day, and up to one week in advance. The default is the current day, so please ensure you've selected the correct day(s). For early dismissal/late arrival, please add in the Note section the time of the early dismissal or late arrival. Remember to press SAVE once you have entered all information!

Telephone by calling the VH attendance line at **248-726-4910** and following the prompts for either allday or part day absences.

Students leaving early will be sent a pass from the office, and should come to the main office at the designated time. They will wait in the office until the parent/guardian arrives in the lobby and signs them out.

Medical Action Plans

We are committed to ensuring the health and safety of all students! Updated Medical Action Plans (MAPs), are required at the start of every school year. MAPs provide Van Hoosen staff with direction about any medical needs such as medication administration, medical interventions and chronic conditions. Students who take medication at school or who carry medical supplies such as Epi-pens, insulin, rescue inhalers, etc. are required to have a MAP on file. All MAP forms may be found <u>on the district website under</u> <u>Health & Wellness</u>. They must be filled out completely and signed by your health care provider. We cannot accept medications without a signed MAP form or MAP forms without a physician signature.


