Recommended Motion: RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Sauquoit Valley Central School District, pursuant to all applicable Civil Service rules and regulations, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, does hereby appoint Henry Rieben to a 2.75 hour permanent teacher aide position at the

elementary school effective September 1, 2024 for a probationary period of 26 weeks to commence on September 1, 2024 and to expire on March 5, 2025.

7.2 Appointment of Office Specialist, 1

Recommended Motion: RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Sauquoit Valley Central School District, pursuant to all applicable Civil Service rules and regulations, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, does hereby appoint Katie Buckingham to the position of Office Specialist, 1, effective September 11, 2024 for a probationary period of 26 weeks to commence on September 11, 2024 and to expire on March 12, 2025, pending civil service exam results.

7.6 Appointment of High School Principal

Recommended Motion: that upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, to appoint Michael Flagg, who is professionally certified as a School Building Leader in the administrator tenure area for a probationary period of three years commencing on November 1, 2024, and expiring on November 1, 2027 (unless extended in accordance with the law). This expiration date is tentative and conditional only. Except to the extent required by the applicable provisions of Section 3012 of the Education Law, in order to be granted tenure a building principal must receive composite or overall annual professional performance review ratings pursuant to Section 3012-c and/or Section 3012-d of the Education Law of either effective or highly effective in at least two (2) of the three (3) preceding years, and if the principal receives an ineffective composite or overall rating in the final year of the probationary period the principal shall not be eligible for tenure at that time.
