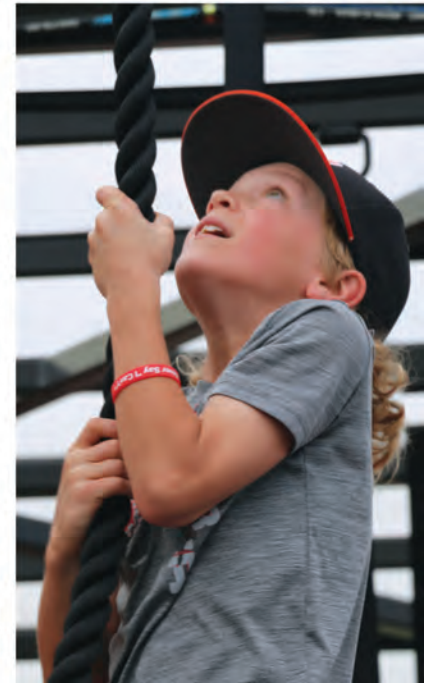

BACK TO SCHOOL INFORMATION:

Early Childhood Screening - Screen At Three

Early Childhood Screening is required by the state of Minnesota for all children prior to entering kindergarten, but the best time to screen a child is between 3 and 4 years old. Screening is a brief, simple procedure used to identify potential health or developmental problems. Screening includes vision and hearing, height and weight, immunization review, large and small muscles, thinking, language and communication skills, as well as social and emotional development.

Minnesota Student Immunization Law

Minnesota Statutes Section 121A.15 and Minnesota Rules Chapter 4604 requires that each student enrolled in and remaining in an elementary or secondary school must submit a record stating that they have received immunizations consistent with medically accepted standards. Immunization records from parents or health care providers stating the month, day, and year of each dose are acceptable. If the student or parent(s) meets one of the legal exemptions - contraindication for medical reasons or contraindication for conscientiously held beliefs - the health care provider or notary needs to sign an appropriate exemption.

Vaccines required for entering kindergarten:

- Hepatitis B - three doses
- DTaP - five doses
- Polio - four doses
- MMR - two doses
- Varicella - two doses

Vaccines required for grades 1-12:

- Hepatitis B - three doses
- DTaP - three doses
- Polio - three doses
- MMR - two doses
- Varicella - two doses

Before entering 7th Grade:

- Tdap - one dose
- Meningococcal - one dose

Before entering 12th Grade:

- Meningococcal - two doses

Emergency Weather Closing

When a decision is made to close schools, an announcement will be made over major radio and television stations as early in the morning as possible. The announcement will identify our school district as White Bear Lake Area Schools. Efforts will also be made to use the parent notification alert system to notify families of school closures. If no announcement is made, schools will be in session as scheduled. Parents may also check the District website or Facebook/Instagram page, or call the White Bear Lake Area School Closing Hotline number at 651-407-7540.

Transportation

Busing information will be posted on the students' Parent Portal by August 29, 2024. Students should be at the bus stop five minutes before the bus is scheduled to arrive. Students are only allowed to ride the bus to and from the school and bus stop they are assigned. Students are not allowed to ride another bus to events such as birthday parties, scouting, or other activities. Bus schedules are somewhat flexible during the first week of school while drivers become familiar with the routes.

In cases of inclement weather, bus drivers will try to maintain their schedules. However, if roads are icy or snow covered, buses may be late and parents and students should plan accordingly. Parents should use their discretion in sending children outside when the weather is extremely cold.

Community Use of School District Facilities

Preschool Programs

A variety of preschool options are available at various locations in the district for children who are 3 or 4 years old by September 1st. The full day programs located in elementary sites have access to busing and Extended Day options.

Our preschools are four-star Parent Aware rated and provide developmentally appropriate, play-based education with licensed preschool teachers that get kids excited about learning. In addition, we work to align our Early Childhood program with kindergarten to ensure a more seamless transition. Elements of that alignment include use of the ECIPS (MN state early childhood standards) to guide instruction, Handwriting Without Tears, implementation of the Conscious Discipline framework for social and emotional learning, and the use of limited assessments that allow us to understand student progress.

Extended Day (School-Age Care)

Extended Day is an out-of-school time program designed to meet the needs of busy families and active kids. The program serves students in grades preK through 5th grade during the school year. Extended Day compliments the school day, encourages social and emotional growth, and emphasizes student creativity, teamwork and communication, and being active.

The program is youth-focused and choice based, giving youth the opportunity to develop strong social skills and positive relationships. Daily program activities include health and fitness, service projects, arts, creative play, language and literacy, science and more.

Extended Day provides programming before and after school, as well as full-day programming on most non-school days and during the summer. The program has daily tuition with flexible scheduling options, including regular and drop-in contracts. Limited financial assistance is available.

Before school..... 6:30 a.m. - school begins
After school..... school dismissal - 6 p.m.
Non-school days6:30 a.m. - 6 p.m.

Breakfast Club

FLEX is the district's out-of-school time program for middle schoolers. The program includes a variety of opportunities for students, including academic support, recreation time, clubs, and service opportunities. It is designed to be a safe, fun, and relaxing space for students to be when not engaged in other activities or sports. In the program, students will continue their social emotional growth, receive support for academic work, and explore passions and interests of their own.

Program runs Monday through Thursday after school and is free for current middle school students during the school year. Students may be picked up, walk or bike home, or use the activity bus.

Ley de vacunación de estudiantes de Minnesota

La Sección 121A.15 de los Estatutos de Minnesota y el Capítulo 4604 de las Reglas de Minnesota requieren que cada estudiante inscrito y que permanezca en una escuela primaria o secundaria debe presentar un registro que indique que ha recibido las vacunas de acuerdo con los estándares médicamente aceptados. Se aceptan registros de vacunación de los padres o proveedores de atención médica que indiquen el mes, el día y el año de cada dosis. Building Our Future Construction Update

This is an historic time for our school district and for the greater White Bear Lake Area community, as we are bringing our ninth through twelfth grade students together into one high school building this fall.

This change from a unique two-campus high school system was made possible by the community's passage of a \$326 million bond referendum, the largest in state history when it was voted upon in 2019.

Creating inspiring environments for students throughout the district has allowed us to realize the vision set forth by our Strategic Planning team. Our students are having more ownership of their learning as flexible learning spaces and learning studios are igniting opportunities for communication, collaboration, creativity and critical thinking.

Changes are also in order for Sunrise Park Middle School students and staff members, who will move into the former WBLAHS - South Campus building that has been converted into Mariner Middle School this summer.

Central Middle School Middle School and the Sunrise Park building will be completed in phases continuing through the fall of 2025. This summer, extensive work has been done at Central Middle School, with a gymnasium addition being added to the school's footprint and renovations being made to existing classroom areas. The summer of 2025 will see renovations made to the current District Center spaces to provide additional square footage for Central Middle School Middle School.

Renovations that began this summer will continue through the school year at the recently-vacated Sunrise Park building. District Services Center offices currently housed at District Center will move to Sunrise mid-year. Beginning in the fall of 2025, Sunrise will also house the Early Childhood Center, Senior Center and Transition Education Center.

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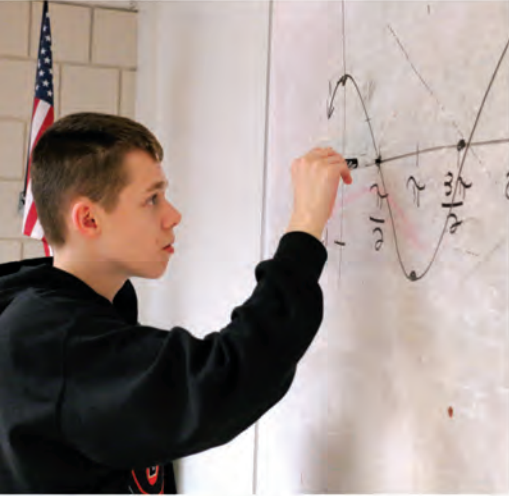
