



Indian Woods Middle School President's Volunteer Service Award Program

The President's Volunteer Service Award (PVSA) is a national program that recognizes and honors students who demonstrate outstanding service to their community, nation, or abroad. Volunteer service hours should be tracked during the twelve-month period between **April 1, 2024 and March 31, 2025**. For students who are between the ages of 11-15 years old, the awards are as follows:

GOLD: 100 or more hours of service

SILVER: 75-99 hours of service

BRONZE: 50-74 hours of service

A variety of volunteer services qualify. Fundraising for community services and faith-based service can be included. Activities must be unpaid. Travel time and annual work time on volunteer trips may be counted.

The following do not qualify for volunteer service hours:

Fundraising for sports teams, choir, plays, etc. from which the student benefits.

Court-ordered community service.

Sleeping or entertainment time after you traveled to the volunteer location.
