SUBJECT: 2024-25 Meal Prices

DATE: August 6, 2024

TYPE: Action Required

Board Policy 3520 requires that the board approve fees for the coming year. Attached are the proposed meal prices for fiscal year 2024-25.

The National School Lunch Program (NSLP) includes federal and state revenues, as well as family paid meals, unless the school or family qualifies for free or reduced prices. NSLP requires as part of the program that districts annually complete a Paid Lunch Equity Tool. As mentioned last year at this time, the tool indicated a price increase of 50 cents for 2023-24, but the district elected to spread the increase over two years.

The Paid Lunch Equity Tool continues to indicate an increase in lunch prices for 2024-25 and 2025-26. In addition, breakfast and milk prices have not been raised since before the 2017-18 school year. For these reasons, and due to overall program cost increases, staff recommend a 25 cent increase in student lunch, breakfast, and a la carte milk prices in the 2024-25 school year.

Recommendation: It is recommended that the Board approve the attached meal prices for the 2024-25 fiscal year, reflecting a 25 cent increase in student lunch, breakfast, and a la carte milk prices.
