	QUESTIONS	ANSWERS
1	Do you have details regarding quantities of leaves hauled/disposed from previous years?	Approximately 15,000-16,000 cubic yards of leaves are trucked away each year.
2	What are the three locations to haul from?	Nye Street Firehouse lot – Legion Field lot behind the National Guard – Church Street lot. (Which is on google maps)
3	Are there truck size limitations at any of the collection points?	N.
4	Is there historical data on total quantities removed from facilities (3) in past/recent years that can be provided to assist bidders in formulation of required bid bond?	Approximately 15,000-16,000 cubic yards of leaves are picked up annually.
5	Are bidders able to view facilities (3) prior to bid submittal deadline?	Yes. These areas can be found on Google Maps. Church street leaf drop off, Legion Field leaf drop off. (Past ball fields near power lines) Nye Street leaf drop off. (Next to Nye Street Firehouse Station 441).
