If you have already applied, please log back into your Scholar Track account to ensure the status of your application- please make sure you hit submit on the application! Completing the application does not guarantee the scholarship, but you will be notified if you qualify once the application has been submitted.

All 6th graders must have Tdap and meningococcal vaccines to be compliant with Indiana state requirements. If your student needs immunizations, take please advantage of the upcoming free clinic on August 29th. (see info below)

Walk-ins the day of the clinic are welcome, but we **MUST** have parent/guardian consent if under the age of 18.

Please upload or send the immunization records for the individual who is getting vaccinated.

Please bring your insurance cards. We accept and bill all insurance (commercial, Medicare, Medicaid). There is no cost to those without insurance, except for the Shingles and adult RSV vaccines, as there is often a required co-pay.

All CDC recommended vaccines will be provided. We will consult the state immunization registry to assess the immunization needs of each individual. If you would like to refuse a specific vaccine, please contact the Indiana Immunization Coalition at least 48 hours prior to the event at clinic@vaccinateindiana.org.

Se proporcionarán todas las vacunas recomendadas por los CDC. Consultaremos el registro estatal de vacunación para evaluar las necesidades de vacunación de cada individuo. 
