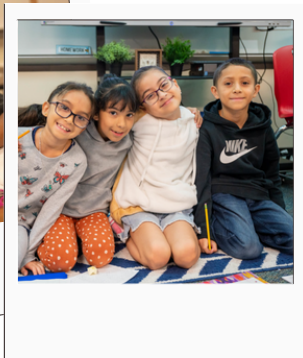

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHT



Klein ISD's Two-Way Dual Language Program is a biliteracy program that integrates native Spanish speakers and native English speakers through literacy in Math, Reading, Language Arts, Science, and Social Studies. Beginning in Kindergarten and continuing through 5th grade, all core subjects are taught 50% in Spanish and 50% in English. Our program's mission is to develop bilingual, biliterate, and socioculturally competent learners.
