## Preschool

This free and required screening is for all Minnesota children and is best done when your child is three years old. The process will obtain a MN student identification number for your child. The evaluation is a simple and careful check of your young child's speech and language, thinking skills, physical development, and social/emotional health. It is designed to ensure the healthy growth of students to be successful in any educational setting and, if necessary, connect them with resources that support their development. For those enrolled in the school district, the assessment must be completed prior to enrollment in the district's preschool or kindergarten programs.

To schedule your child's evaluation, call the Early Learning Center at 320-762-3305.

Birth Certificate Required: You will need to present a copy of the birth certificate to verify the child's date of birth and legal name. A child is eligible to enroll in the Alexandria Public Schools if he/she is five years of age on or before September 1. If your child was born in Douglas County and you do not have a copy, you may obtain a copy of your child's birth certificate at:
