Greetings Johnston Families.

Welcome to the 2024-2025 School Year!

My name is Yer Lor and I am new to Johnston Elementary this year as your partner in education and your child's School Counselor My family and I live in Menasha where my children attend school. I have three children at the high school, and one at Maplewood Middle in seventh grade. Before Johnston, I was an Elementary School Counselor at Columbus Elementary. Appleton Bilingual, and Ferber Elementary in the Appleton Area School District the past five years. Already, I feel so welcomed and supported by the staff, students, and families at Johnston Elementary and I am so excited to be here!

I would like to take the time to tell you about our Comprehensive School Counseling program at Johnston Elementary. The School Counseling program is for all students. As part of our School Counseling curriculum, we teach standards referred to as Student Mindsets and Behaviors from the American School Counseling Association (ASCA) that will be taught twice a month throughout the school year. These lessons will teach students lifelong skills that add to their personal growth and social-emotional development. Topics will include communication skills/styles, self-awareness, self-management, acceptance of self and others, career exploration and interests, personal safety, and healthy choices. In addition to the educational component of the School Counseling program, I do meet with students on a short term basis. I meet with students one-on-one and in groups offering specific small group topics that focus on skill development or personal support. Some topics include, but are not limited to anxiety, divorce/changing families, loss/grief, friendships, social skills, emotional regulation, etc. Referrals can be made by a parent, staff member, or student.

I look forward to being a part of the Johnston family working with your child(ren) and collaborating with families and staff to provide the best educational experience for all students. THIS MONTH IN PHY. ED.

Welcome back Johnston parents and students. We are looking forward to a great year filled with growth, learning, and fun in Physical Education.

During our first week the K-2nd Grade students will be working on practicing rules, routines, and procedures through interactive games and activities. We will begin by focusing on how to safely move around the gym using our 8 locomotor movements. Throughout our activities and instruction, we will have an emphasis on developing strong teamwork, sportsmanship, and communication.

For the first couple of weeks in September the 3-5th Grade students will work on developing teamwork, communication, and problem-solving skills with the peers in their class. We will then begin to talk about our 5 Fitness Components and work on improving in the different areas of fitness.

Lastly, I want to remind all families that students should come to Phy Ed with a clean pair of tennis shoes each day. It does not have to be a separate pair just for Phy Ed, but we just ask that students are not coming to Phy Ed in muddy shoes, boots, heels, crocs, or sandals. Also, historically the first couple of weeks of school are hot and humid. Please encourage your students to stay hydrated at home and throughout the school day.
