Your Student's Safety Matters

Dismissal/Arrival Safety DO's:

- Closely supervise your children
- Pull all the way forward when driving in the pick-up/drop off lane
 - o Remain in your vehicle if you are in the pick up lane
 - o If you do not see your child, continue to circle around
- Park in the parking lot or near school if you will be exiting your vehicle
- Use the crosswalk
 - Wait for the cross guard to stop the vehicles before crossing
- Arrive on time for dismissal and arrival

Dismissal/Arrival Do NOT's:

- Allow children to run in the dismissal area or damage greenery
- Allow children to climb school fixtures
- Cross to the parking lot in undesignated areas
- Keep younger siblings waiting until upper grade release (unless they are accompanied by a non-staff adult)
- Do NOT block:
 - Fire Hydrants
 - $\circ~$ Driveways (we have received complaints from neighbors)
 - o Bus lane

Late Drop Offs:

All students will have to walk on their own to their classroom if they arrive late to class (parents are not to walk to classrooms after the school day has started as this will interrupt the flow of classroom procedures).

The only exception to this is TK students, they may be walked to their class by parents if they arrive late. Kinder to 6th grade students should walk to their classrooms on their own.

Uniform Policy:

Cellphone Policy:

- All cell phones must be turned off and remain in backpacks during the school day. Per our school handbook: "If your child has a cell phone at school, it must be turned off during school hours and kept in their backpacks. The school accepts no responsibility regarding loss, damage, etc. of the phones."
 - $\circ~$ If student is caught using phone during school hours:
 - 1st Warning; prompted to put away
 - 2nd Administration/Teachers will hold item for parent pick up
 - 3rd Parent/Teacher/Administration Meeting

Smart Watch Policy:

- Smart watches may be allowed to be on campus and worn during school hours.
 - Students are not allowed to call parents/guardians from smart watch while on school campus.
 - If student is caught using smart watch during school hours:
 - 1st Warning; prompted to stop
 - 2nd Administration/Teachers will hold item for parent pick up
 - 3rd Parent/Teacher/Administration Meeting

School Absences:

If you have any student out sick, not feeling well, your student will be late, or will be having a doctor's or dentist appointment please make sure you call our <u>main office at 650-312-7737</u>. After the 3rd day, if your student continues to be sick you will need to provide a doctors note to the office a week from the 3rd day missed. Please make sure you call <u>before 10:00am</u> on the day that your student will be absent and not the following day. If you don't notify us your student will be marked absent.

If your student is absent please make sure to bring a medical note as soon as the next day or when your student returns to school so that we may correct their attendance with enough time.
