








Elementary Program Updated Curriculum

Looking Ahead to 2025

- Four weeks of programming
- Eligibility criteria may be adjusted based on capacity
- Increased enrollment
- Continued focus on highly engaging, activity-based curriculum and positive relationships





Extended School Year (ESY)

July 8th-25th

- Approximately 460 students served from ECSE to age 22
- Approximately 60 licensed staff plus related service providers
- Approximately 100 paraprofessionals and other support staff

Sites: Liberty Ridge Site II, Grey Cloud Elementary, Cottage Grove Elementary, Cottage Grove Middle School, East Ridge High School, and Pathways School and community-based & workbased learning.



Credit Recovery

- Coordinated by South Washington Alternative High School
- Over 400 credits earned over the course of the summer
 - o Park High School: 99
 - Woodbury High School: 190
 - East Ridge High School: 86
 - South Washington Alternative High School: 26.5
