

Pickup Policy:

Pickup from BASE runs from 4:45 - 5 p.m., in front of the school on Maple Leaf Place. If you need to pick up your student early from BASE, please contact the front office or send an email to BASE@SJCS.net. Picking up students at the park is NOT permitted. *LATE PICK UP OF 15 MINUTES OR MORE WILL RESULT IN A \$20 CHARGE.

This class incorporates fun and discipline, while also teaching students basic Kung Fu / Wushu self-defense techniques. Students learn the basics of stretching, punching, kicking, blocking, tumbling, while enhancing their hand/eye coordination and balance.

Braiding, knotting, beading, and more, students in this class will design their own bracelets each week, expressing their personalities through colorful designs. Whether making bracelets for themselves, family members, or friends, each week of the class is a chance to create something new!

This class is for all ages and skill levels, teaching chess rules, history, and exploring different strategies in the game. Each student will receive a ChessKid* gold membership account with joining this class. In addition to learning the traditional game, the class will branch out and explore different variants of the game, even allowing students to create their own! In 2023-2024, OCA instructed eight Washington State Elementary and Middle School Chess Champions, including two from SJCS!
