FALL BREAK- OCTOBER 14th-16th

Fall Break registration for families needing Full-time care for all three (3) days opened on **Friday, August 30 at 9:00 AM and will close on Monday, September 6 at 9:00 AM.** Enrolled BASE families needing Full Day BASE care during Fall Break must register. Space is available on a first-come, first-serve basis. Part-time or daily care options are not available.
