Andover Board of Education Notes Aug. 12, 2024

Spotlight on Learning: Jill Lachenmayr, assistant superintendent for academic affairs, <u>provided an update</u> on summer school, professional learning, curriculum alignment, federal funds and more.

Out-of-district enrollment update: Jeremy Boldra, assistant superintendent for human resources, provided an update on the state's new out-of-district enrollment law. The district advertised 338 open seats and filled approximately 121 of those seats. Three grades (3rd, 6th and 9th) required a lottery to select students because there were more applicants than seats available. Three grades (8th, 10th and 12th) did not have capacity. The addition of these students will keep enrollment relatively flat.

Temporary bond projects: Richard Bell, executive director of operations, presented two projects to be paid for using existing bond authority from the 2017 election – parking lot repairs at Andover Central High School for \$110,259.50 and parking lot repairs at Sunflower Elementary School for \$8,745. The projects were approved.

District goals and initiatives: The Board voted to approve <u>2024-25 goals and initiatives</u> that had been presented at its July meeting.

Superintendent's report: Supt. Brett White reported about beginning-of-school professional learning and visits to schools Aug. 14-16.
