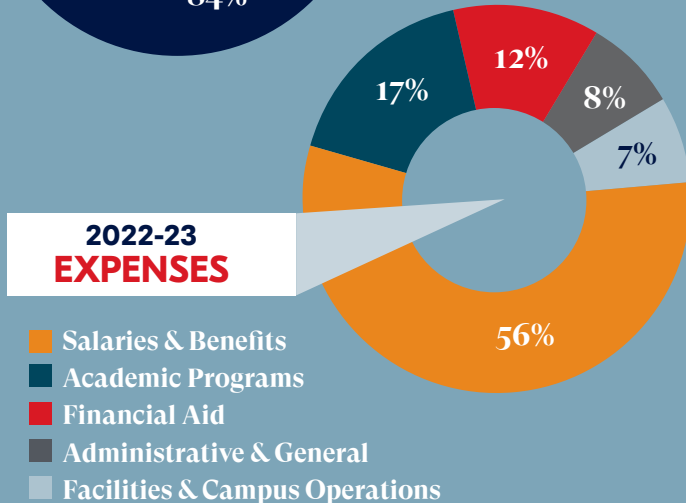
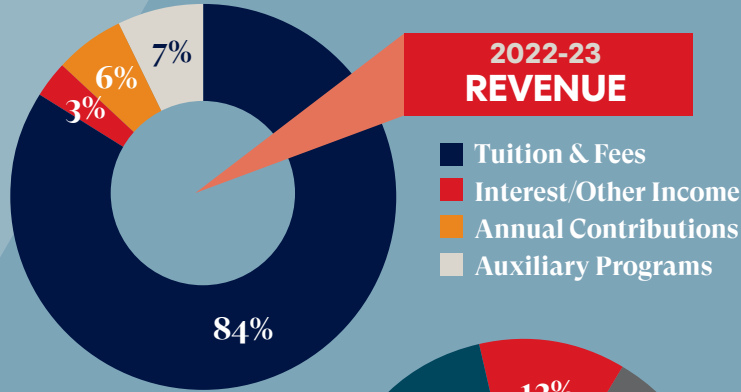


Why Giving Matters
