- June 10-14th 8-11am & 12-3pm
- 15 hours of ELA and/or Math intervention hours for HB1416
- High leverage TEKS instruction
- NEF provided snacks, books, and teaching supplies

#### **Secondary**

- June 10-14th 8-11am & 12-3pm
- 6th-8th grade students who have low STAAR 2.0 raw scores, along with other data such as low achievement in classroom performance, MAP, or CBA data
- High school students who do not reach the approaches level on the Algebra I, Biology, English I/II, and/or US History EOCs
- 15 hours of HB 1416 Accelerated Instruction hours
- NEF provided snacks and teaching supplies

#### **Credit Recovery**

- Opportunity to recoup credits through online classes which cover the content originally delivered in a face-to- face class
- Delivered through Edgenuity, a web-based instructional program with NISD teacher support
- \$50 (\$25 for Free and Reduced)

#### **Original Credit**

- A student who needs to complete credits at an accelerated pace in order to create space in their schedule
- A transfer student who has not had the opportunity to take required coursework or who needs to take/complete any required course that is not offered in a face-to-face classroom setting.
- A student who is advanced in age and severely behind in credits.
- \$100 (\$50 for Free and Reduced)

## **ESY**

#### **ESY: Extended School Year**

- Provides progression recoupment of skills
- For students receiving special education services.
- Must be recommended by ARD committee
- June 4-27 or July 9-18
- 30 students participated

#### **Newcomer Camp**

- Experiential language camp for Newcomers
- 1st-10th grade

#### **Language Academy**

- To extend the opportunity for EB students to develop academic language skills in English and their home language, if applicable, and strengthen content knowledge and skills.


