

**PIEDMONT UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT**  
**RESOLUTION 26-2019-20**  
**THE EDUCATION PROTECTION ACCOUNT**

**WHEREAS**, the voters approved Proposition 30 on November 6, 2012 and Proposition 55 on November 8, 2016 that added Article XIII, Section 36 to the California Constitution;

**WHEREAS**, the provisions of Article XIII, Section 36(e) create in the state General Fund an Education Protection Account to receive and disburse the revenues derived from the incremental increases in taxes imposed by Article XIII, Section 36(f);

**WHEREAS**, all monies in the Education Protection Account are hereby continuously appropriated for the support of school districts, county offices of education, charter schools and community college districts; and

**WHEREAS**, a school district has the sole authority to determine how the monies received from the Education Protection Account are spent in the school or schools within its jurisdiction; and

**WHEREAS**, the governing board of the district shall make the spending determinations with respect to monies received from the Education Protection Account in open session of a public meeting of the governing board; and

**WHEREAS**, the monies received from the Education Protection Account shall not be used for salaries or benefits for administrators or any other administrative cost;


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**

1. The monies received from the Education Protection Account shall be spent as required by Article XIII, Section 36 and the spending determinations on how the money will be spent shall be made in open session of a public meeting of the Board of Education of the Piedmont Unified School District.
2. In compliance with Article XIII, Section 36(e) of the California Constitution, the Board of Education of the Piedmont Unified School District has determined to spend the monies received from the Education Protection Act as attached.
