### What is ParentSquare?

ParentSquare is how SFCSD communicates with families and the community at-large.

#### **LONG ANSWER:**

You will be able to use ParentSquare to:

- Receive all school, classroom, and group communication via email, text, or app notification
- See important calendar events and RSVP to them
- See photos, links, and attachments
- Sign permission forms digitally

- Sign up for parent/teacher conferences, to volunteer, or to bring items
- Join and participate in groups
- Send private messages to teachers or staff
- Appreciate those who post messages

### How do I activate my ParentSquare account?

As long as your contact info is correct in SchoolTool, you will automatically receive school communications from ParentSquare (PS) in your email. However, you will need to have an activated PS account to engage in 2-way communication. The good news is, if your SchoolTool contact is up-do-date, your PS account is ready and waiting to be activated!

#### TO ACTIVATE YOUR PARENTSQUARE ACCOUNT:

- Visit parentsquare.com/signin
- type your email into the "**Register**" section (it must be the same email listed as your contact in SchoolTool).
- Click Get Started and follow the prompts.

## Is the app worth it, and how do I get it?

You can access ParentSquare through a browser on your computer, but from a parent/guardian perspective, the app often offers the most streamlined and accessible experience.
