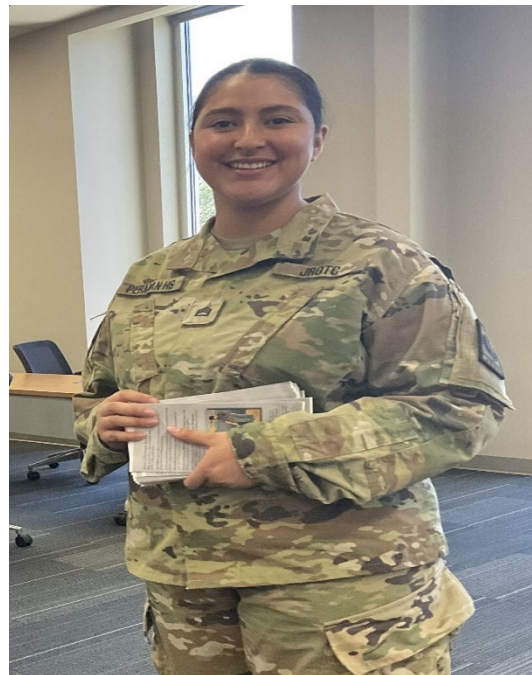
Student Interaction

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Resource and Education to Help Teen Parents Career Development

Both of these students are determined to stay in school, graduate, then continue to college. Brigitte's schedule does include a career prep class that helps students prepare for career success. TPRS is collaborating with the Texas Workforce Solutions of the Permian Basin. They are one of the support agencies assisting our students in finding a job as needed. This will help our teen parents stay in school and work half day if they qualify for the program. The workforce sets them up with open positions in our community that will best fit our student's needs. The Workforce Solution also offers our teen moms the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) program at no cost to them.
