A. CALL TO ORDER

Chairperson Easter called the meeting to order at 6:02pm. All Board members were present – Amy Hennen, Melody Skelly, Kelly McClellan, Allie Schmidt, Marilyn Forsberg, Sam Vilella, Tony Easter, along with Superintendent Dr. Jeff Ronneberg.

B. AGENDA APPROVAL

Motion by Schmidt, seconded by McClellan, to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried unanimously with all members present voting yes. (7-0)

C. DISCUSSION ITEMS

1. 2024-25 District Operational Plan (DOP) – Dr. Hope Rahn, Executive Director for Learning and Innovation and Kelly Stewart, Coordinator of Learning Analytics reviewed the 2024-25 school year District Operational Plan highlighting a summary of spring 2023 student achievement results, portraits of readiness of students at key transitions times of 4th, 8th, and 12th grades, as well as improvement projects to reach the goals and desired results of the 2024-25 school year. Two projects within the DOP were review: Deepen Student Engagement through Innovative and Personalized Learning, Enhance Communication of Individual Student Learning Progress. Board member's questions and comments focused on the importance, influence and impact of so many factors on a student's learning. The review at tonight's meets the MDE's Comprehensive Achievement and Civic Readiness requirements (formerly called World's Best Workforce)
