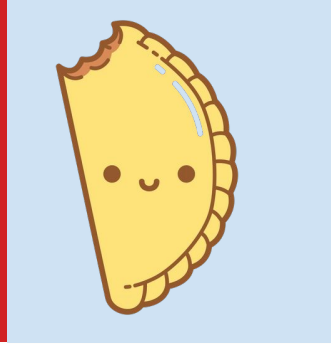
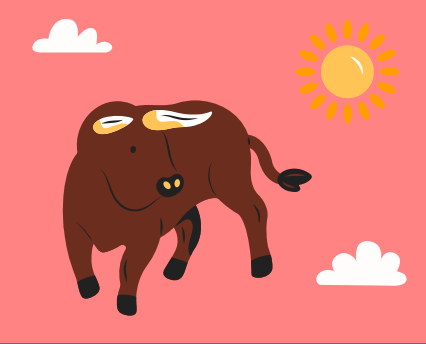

The Yearbook Club is an opportunity for students from all three grade levels to participate in the design and production of the Westlake Middle School's annual yearbook.

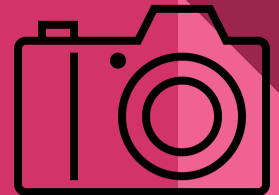

Talent Show

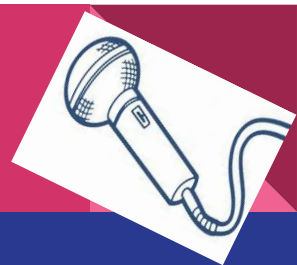
*Do you have an impressive singing voice, acting ability or a hidden talent?

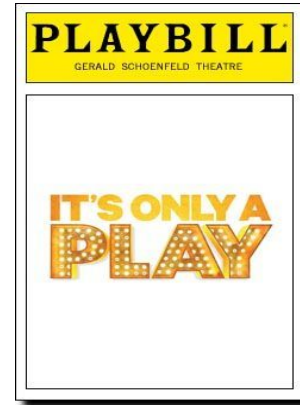

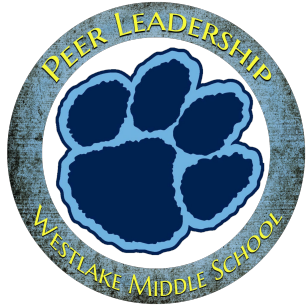
