The BVLS Food Service Department provides Breakfast and lunch to all students in the district. Families need to complete the Free and Reduced Price Family Application to qualify for free or reduced-price meals. Click Here for the application. A new application must be completed every year.

Students who do not qualify for free or reduced-price meals must pay full price for breakfast and lunch.

What is the Hunger Games?

The Delaware County Fights Against Hunger Games is a county-wide initiative coordinated by the Delaware County Court to provide Thanksgiving Meals to Delaware County residents in need of a little extra assistance. The meal comes complete with all of the fixin's or a delicious dinner including a Turkey and is free to any Delaware County resident. Now what is the Hunger Games Trophy?
