

A RESOLUTION ADOPTED BY UNANIMOUS VOTE ON SEPTEMBER 4, 2024, BY THE DOUGLAS COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT LONG RANGE PLANNING COMMITTEE

The Long Range Planning Committee has reviewed the Bond Resolution and the accompanying Bond Plan adopted by the Douglas County Board of Education on August 27th 2024. The Committee recognizes the critical need for additional financial investment in the capital needs of the existing schools of the district. These investments are necessary to continue to provide a safe, reliable, and appropriate learning environment for the students of the district.

The Long Range Planning Committee has also strongly expressed the need for additional school capacity in areas of the district where rapid growth of the student population has occurred. The construction of two new elementary schools in those areas and the expansion of one middle school, as described in the Bond Resolution and Bond Plan, is necessary to meet the needs of students in those areas for modern safe neighborhood schools.

The Long Range Planning Committee finds that the Bond Resolution adopted by the Board of Education is a fiscally responsible plan to address the significant concerns previously identified by the Committee and described above.

The Long Range Planning Committee hereby supports the Bond Resolution and Bond Plan of the Board of Education.
