Spanish I

Spanish I is a beginning foreign language course designed to introduce students to the Spanish language and basic elements of beginning grammar. Emphasis will be placed on vocabulary, culture, civilization, and history. The Standards for Modern Languages encourage foreign language taught in communicative context, and therefore will be taught in contextual thematic units.

Objectives

- Exchange simple spoken and written information in Spanish, utilizing cultural references
- Demonstrate skills necessary to sustain brief oral or written exchange in Spanish
- Understand simple spoken and written language presented through a variety of media in the target language based on topics such as self, family, school, etc.
- Present information orally and in writing that contains a variety of vocabulary, phrases, and patterns
- Develop an awareness of perspectives, practices, and products of Spanish-speaking cultures
- Use information acquired in the study of Spanish and other subjects to reinforce one another
- Compare the basic elements of Spanish to the basic elements of English
- Identify situations and resources in which Spanish-speaking skills and cultural knowledge may be applied beyond the classroom setting for recreational, educational, and occupational purposes

Expectations for Academic Success

- Attend class daily.
- Be respectful, and be an active learner. ¡Participa!
- Be punctual! You are expected to begin warm-up activity immediately each day.
- Be prepared with your notebook, paper, and pencil/pen and in your assigned seat when class begins.
- Follow directions the first time they are given.
- Raise your hand, and wait until you are recognized before speaking or leaving your seat.

Final Exam

All courses will have a culminating exam or project that assesses associate learning of the semester's course content. This exam will be 20% of the overall course grade.

Unscored/Unweighted Assignments

A grade will not be given for every assignment. Some assignments will be practice and are designed to let the teacher and parents know how the student is progressing. These assignments will not count as part of the official grade. No assignment is negotiable; all must be completed.

Weekly Verb Quizzes

Associates will have a verb quiz each week. These verbs are a snapshot of the unit vocabulary. Students are expected to prepare for these quizzes each week. Quizlet flashcards are provided in Google Classroom.

Make-up Work

Associates who are absent are required to contact the instructor for make-up work. The associate will have the same number of days they are absent to complete the make-up work.

Late Work Policy

Meeting deadlines is very important in life beyond high school. Students who develop the self-discipline necessary to commit to and follow through with tasks that they do not particularly enjoy or that interfere with their entertainment are better prepared to meet the demands of college and careers. 
Remind.com
