**11th Grade** As a reminder, the PSAT will be administered on Thursday, October 10th, to all students in Grade 11. The College Board requires that each student complete a Digital Readiness Check prior to the exam. We need to complete these checks in smaller groups given the demand on the Wifi to download the app.

We will be completing the Digital Readiness Check for ALL Juniors on Thursday, September 26th. Students will be scheduled for one period with their school counselor to complete the check, although some students will not need the entire period and will return to class. The periods that will be used are as follows: Periods 2, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 & 9.

**12th Grade** Harrison High School is proud to offer the ACT on Thursday, October 17th, 2024 and the SAT on Friday, October 25th, 2024. Taking the ACT or SAT can be an important component of the college admissions process as some colleges use these exams to measure college readiness and predict future academic success.

Ordering information for each of the exams is listed below. Each student's exam will be ordered upon collection of payment. No refunds will be issued if you decide to not sit for the exam after the order has been placed. - The Online ACT: Thursday, October 17th, 2024; The exam will be given without the writing section. The cost of the exam without writing is \$53.25. Cash or check are acceptable forms of payment and checks should be made payable to Harrison Central School District. Payment and the attached paper registration form (also available in the Guidance Office) **must be submitted to the Guidance Office by the end of the school day on Friday, September 13th. No late registrations will be accepted.**
- The Digital SAT: Friday, October 25th, 2024; The cost of the exam is \$60. Cash or check are acceptable forms of payment and checks should be made payable to Harrison Central School District. Payment and the attached paper registration form (also available in the Guidance Office) **must be submitted to the Guidance Office by the end of the school day on Friday, September 13th. No late registrations will be accepted.**

Please note- If you plan to sit for both the SAT and ACT, separate payments must be made for each.
