On September 6, 2024, your student was presented with information on the CFISD Code of Conduct and how they can help make their school and community safer by reporting dangerous or concerning behaviors.

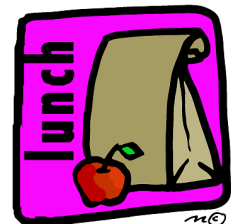

Lunch Visitors



Lunch Visitors begins Tuesday, September 3, 2024. Two (2) visitors per student one time per week will be allowed in for lunch. Reminder: only parents/guardians may visit for lunch at this time (no younger siblings).

Parents/Guardians may bring food and beverages for their child, but they **may not** bring food/drinks for other children. Many parents/guardians treat their children to special lunches from outside restaurants occasionally. While we encourage you to reward your children with these special celebrations, we ask that if you are bringing your child lunch that you arrive on time. To protect instructional time, any student waiting on a parent/guardian ten minutes after lunch has begun will be sent through the cafeteria line.

As a reminder, we do not accept lunch drop offs. We will deliver water bottles and jackets. In order to avoid any disruptions, parents in costumes will not be allowed to enter the campus.

Visitors and Raptor 6



All visitors to the school will be checked into the building in two ways:

1. All visitors will be required to use the Raptor 6 (this requires a valid driver's license/photo identification).
2. All visitors' identification will be matched with our school information (as provided by the parent on the emergency contact card).

If individuals other than the parent/guardian are coming for lunch or to attend an event, we must receive a written note from the parent/guardian. If we do not receive a written note, the visitor will not be permitted to enter the building. If you know an individual is coming to have lunch at school or attend an event, it is important that:

1. The parent accompanies the visitor.
2. The parent provide written notification to the front office prior to the visit.

Newly Enrolled CFISD Students – SCOPE Act

The SCOPE Act, which stands for Securing Children Online through Parental Empowerment. Through the SCOPE Act, parents have the right to direct and informed consent over their child's access to digital tools, software, and applications. Please visit the CFISD website at <https://www.cfisd.net/student> software for a clear explanation of the SCOPE Act and a list of software your child will be using as part of the CFISD curriculum. The Student Approved Lists are organized by grade level. As a parent, you have the right to opt your child out of using Approved Student Software. If you choose to do so, please understand:



- Your child will **not** be issued a Chromebook for use beyond required online assessments
- Your child will not be able to access software applications used in any class or activity

Attendance

Your child's success is directly related to excellent attendance. Our overall school attendance rate is an indicator on our state accountability rating and effects Warner's overall success. Students arriving after 8:15 a.m. are tardy. **Attendance is marked daily at 10:07 a.m.** Students who are absent should submit a written excuse (parent note or doctor's excuse) upon returning to school or you may email it to Warner@cfisd.net. Excessive tardies/absences will be referred to the district's truancy officer.
