Rules for Public Participation

The Board of Education welcomes all visitors to its meetings. Board Policy 0167.3 governs public participation in such meetings.

If you would like to address the board, please remember the following:

1. There is a time set aside in the agenda for public participation. If you would like to address the board, please sign in by 5:50 p.m. at the sign-in table located outside the auditorium doors.

2. Generally, each person who addresses the Board shall be allowed to speak for up to five minutes.

3. Each person who wishes to address the Board must register himself/herself with their name and address at least 10 minutes prior to the scheduled start time of the meeting. If the comments made by a person constitute a complaint against a board member's or employee's performance of their jobs, the board member or employee has a right to request a closed hearing. Personal attacks of board members, employees or students, unrelated to the administration of the district, are not permitted by Board Policy 0167.3 paragraph G.

4. Board of Education members may question speakers but are not obligated to answer questions or make statements or commitments in response to issues raised by the public. In general, issues raised by speakers will be referred to the superintendent for investigation, study and recommendation or possibly designated as a future agenda item for board consideration.

About the Board of Education

Board of Education elections are held biennially at the even year elections in November.

The Davison Board of Education operates the largest business in the area, with a budget totalling nearly \$60 million and providing jobs for more than 700 employees.
