That the sum of \$3,500,363 be appropriated for the purpose of funding the Barnstable High School 21<sup>st</sup> Century Learning Space Project as outlined in the FY 2018 - FY 2021 Capital Improvement Plan, including the payment of costs incidental or related thereto; and that to meet this appropriation, that the Town Treasurer, with the approval of the Town Manager, is authorized to borrow \$3,158,000 and that in accordance with Chapter 44, Section 20 of the General Laws, any premium received by the Town upon the sale of any bonds or notes thereunder, less any such premium applied to the payment of the costs of issuance of such bonds and notes, may be applied to pay such project costs and that \$342,363 be transferred from the remaining available balances in previously approved Town Council orders as follows:


