Activity 2 Career Interest

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Inform students that the interest assessment will help them find a "Holland Code," which will help connect them to different careers that may "fit" their interests and personalities. Explain to students that there are six interest areas in the Holland code. These are often referred to as "RIASEC" which is an acronym for Holland's original six types: Realistic-Doer, Investigative-Thinker, Artistic-Creator, Social-Helper, Enterprising-Persuader, and Conventional-Organizer
- 2. Students will answer several questions to determine their career interests based on their Holland Code:


3. Review the Holland Code Video:
