

Hello, Seniors and Parents/Guardians,

Attached you will find information and forms regarding the **Bishop DuBourg Senior Service Project**. Your senior will be reviewing the same information in religion classes, and we will discuss the forms, requirements, expectations, and deadlines at a class meeting.

Seniors will need to design their own service projects - either one large scale project or a number of smaller projects OR will need to find their own personal service site. **All seniors will be off school from January 3rd-17th to work on their service projects.** In addition to the dates and deadlines below, we have included a **Guidelines for Choosing Your Senior Service Project** page to help seniors come up with meaningful service projects.

Below is a list of important dates and deadlines for the Senior Service Project. Please mark your calendars. **All forms are available on the Senior Service Project tab under Christian Service on the DB website.**

**Important Dates and Deadlines:**

<b>Sept. 11th</b>	Senior Class Meeting during Family Time to explain Service Projects and requirements
<b>November 1st</b>	<b>Design-Your-Own Project</b> and <b>Personal Service Site</b> requests submitted to Campus Ministry and Administration for approval. Archdiocesan <b>Code of Ethics Form</b> printed, signed, and returned to Campus Ministry. <b>PARENT APPROVAL FORM</b> submitted to Campus Ministry
<b>November 22nd</b>	Confirmation of service sites and projects by Campus Ministry- will be communicated to students via email
<b>Dec 9th</b>	Commissioning Service Liturgy
<b>Jan 6th-17th</b>	Dates for all seniors to work on the Senior Service Project (RETURN TO SCHOOL JANUARY 18th) (first two weeks of school)
<b>Jan 22th</b>	<b>Personal Senior Service Helper Helper</b> is due <b>Design-Your-Own Project Timesheet</b> due to review project progress
<b>Jan 24th</b>	Witnessing Liturgy
<b>Mar 24th</b>	All <b>Design-Your-Own Projects</b> must be completed and all hours submitted (week after spring break)

**GUIDELINES FOR CHOOSING YOUR SENIOR SERVICE PROJECT**

All seniors must choose a service opportunity from the choices listed below. **Your choice of a Personal Service Site or Design Your Own Project is due on November 1st.** All seniors will be off school from **January 6th - 17th** to work on their service projects.

Choices:

## 1) Personal Service Site

- If you choose a **Personal Service Site** you will need to fill out a **Personal Service Site Information Google Form** and must submit by **November 1st**
- Seniors should choose a site from our **Service Opportunities** link, on our **Christian Service** page located under the **Faith and Service** tab on the DB website, ([Service Opportunities](#)), or from a personal family connection with a site.
- The senior is responsible for contacting the agency/site and arranging to serve **70 hours during the service project weeks in January or to be arranged during the senior's personal time after school or on the weekends by Nov. 1.**
  - The student must complete the **Service Hours** and turn it in by **Jan. 22nd.**

## 2) Design-Your-Own Project

- If you choose a **Design Your Own Project**, you will need to fill out a **Design Your Own Project Information Google Form** and must submit by **November 1st**
- A separate **Design-Your-Own Project Timesheet** will be sent after all choices are finalized. ● Your project(s) must total **70 hours.**
- This project must contain 4 elements:
  1. Planning and preparation(to include time estimates)
  2. Marketing/gathering supplies
  3. Implementation
  4. Reflection
- **This can be one large project or a few smaller projects**, accomplished alone or in a small group with **no more than three classmates.**
- **Each project**, regardless of size, requires a separate **“Project Timesheet”**, all of which are due by **March 21st**
- **All projects** must be approved by the administration **before beginning.**

### **Some larger project ideas include:**

- Designing/building/stocking a neighborhood Little Free Library

### **Some smaller project ideas include:**

- Organizing a drive - coat/clothing, food, personal hygiene, cleaning items
- Organizing a letter-writing campaign to residents at a nursing home for the holidays:
  - Thanksgiving,
  - Christmas,
  - Valentine's Day,
  - St.Patrick's Day,
  - Easter
- Sewing masks for agencies in need - homeless shelters, nursing homes, etc.
- Sewing or tying fleece blankets for the homeless shelters or St. Vincent de Paul
