A special meeting was held at 7:00 P.M.

The meeting, prompted by five complaints filed by a resident of Suffield on August 21, 2024, was called to order by Chairman Jay Presser at 7:00 P.M. The purpose of the meeting was to conduct an inquiry, pursuant to its rules, to decide whether any, or all, of the complaint(s) established probable cause to believe a violation of the Code of Ethics had occurred, so as to warrant an investigation.

The meeting began with the recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance followed by a roll call.
