What should I do if I test positive for COVID-19?

If you test positive for COVID-19 you should stay home and away from others until at least 24 hours after both your symptoms are getting better overall and you have not had a fever.

What should I do upon returning to work?

For at least five days after your symptoms have stopped, it is recommended that you take precautionary measures such as masking, social distancing, and frequent handwashing.

What about paid COVID leave?

NYS Paid COVID Leave was provided when employees who tested positive were subject to an order of quarantine or isolation issued by the NYS Department of Health. These orders are no longer being issued, so paid COVID leave is no longer available.

What about cleaning of classrooms and shared spaces?

When we are made aware that someone tested positive for COVID-19, our cleaning crew will conduct a thorough cleaning of the classroom and/or shared spaces where the individual may have been. This is consistent with our previous COVID-19 procedures.

Free COVID tests are available in the nurse's office in each building.
