

Notification of Availability

Notify building occupants (or legal guardians) annually regarding compliance with the AHERA program. This requires a Notification of Availability. It can be a written letter or publication explaining the facility's compliance with the AHERA regulations and location of the Management Plan. This must be done annually, *even in schools where there is no longer asbestos materials*. This must be dated.

**NOTIFICATION OF AVAILABILITY
OF ASBESTOS MANAGEMENT PLAN**

The 1987 Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) not only requires inspections of all public and private schools (K-12 grades) to identify asbestos-containing building materials, but also requires that an Asbestos Management Plan be developed to safely manage the identified asbestos in each school facility. To further ensure that the identified asbestos-containing materials are maintained in a safe condition, AHERA also requires that the asbestos materials be checked every six months and that these materials be re-inspected by an IDEM accredited inspector every three years to reassess the condition of the asbestos, for as long as the materials remain in the building.

The Asbestos Management Plan is available for your review. Anyone wishing to view a copy of the Management Plan for an individual school will find it available in the principal's office of each school. The Management Plan may be copied, at a nominal fee during regular school hours. Please notify the school in advance to prevent scheduling difficulties.
