Excelsior Families;

To protect the health and safety of our students, families and staff Excelsior Charter Schools will restrict on-campus activities at school sites with poor air quality related to the ongoing fires. We are in constant contact with our regional Air Quality Management Districts and the San Bernardino County Superintendent of Schools to inform our decisions. During these on campus restrictions we are requiring all students to complete assignments independently using our Canvas learning management system and will hold Individualized Education Plan meetings virtually employing internet safety best practices. Our website will be updated periodically as new information is received to communicate projected campus closures and or when normal operations will be resumed at the impacted school sites. We are also adding HEPA filtration to classrooms as an additional safety measure at our school sites nearest the fire zones.

Thank you for your understanding in this matter. All school sites can be contacted by phone and our teaching staff is available from 8am-4pm to assist your student. Please use email as an initial step as our phone lines are likely inundated with ongoing communication and support.
