**Description of the possible adverse effects of the pesticides as per the Material Safety Data Sheets for the pesticides to be used, if available:**

- If swallowed • Immediately call a poison control center or doctor. • DO NOT induce vomiting unless told to by a poison control center or doctor. • DO NOT give any liquid to the person. • DO NOT give anything to an unconscious person.
- If inhaled • Move person to fresh air. • If person is not breathing, call 911 or ambulance; then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth to mouth, if possible. • Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.
- If on skin • Take off contaminated clothing. • Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15 to 20 minutes. • Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.
- If in eyes • Hold eyes open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15 to 20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes; then continue rinsing. • Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

**Pesticide(s) product label instructions and precautions related to Public Safety:**

- Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet.
- Remove clothing/PPF immediately if pesticide gets inside. Then wash thoroughly and put on clean clothing.
- Remove PPE immediately after handling this product. Wash the outside of gloves before removing. As soon as possible, wash thoroughly and change into clean clothing. If swallowed
