The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by President Noble Quandel.

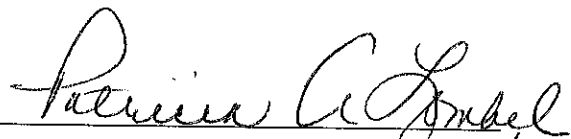
