SUBJECT: FY23 STATE ASSESSMENT RESULTS RELEASE

The Florida Department of Education (FLDOE) has released the FY23 results of the Florida Assessment of Student Thinking (FAST) for English Language Arts (ELA) and Mathematics; B.E.S.T. Algebra 1 and Geometry End of Course Exams; Biology, Civics, and US History NGSSS End of Course Exams, and State Science Assessments.¹

The FAST assessments for ELA (VPK through grade 10 Reading) and mathematics (VPK through grade 8 Mathematics) are progress monitoring (PM) assessments and are administered three times per year. The administration of PM1 occurs at the very beginning of the school year and is designed to provide a baseline score so teachers can begin to track student achievement progress. PM2 is administered mid-year and PM3 is the summative assessment of standards-based learning for the school year. Per the Florida Department of Education (FLDOE), comparison from FY22 student performance to FY23 student performance should not be made due to the change from the FSA to the new FAST progress monitoring system.

In light of the new progress monitoring system, the FLDOE instructs parents that results from PM1 and PM2 are for informational purposes only, are used to identify areas that may need additional instruction or support, and should not be considered student achievement designations. Therefore, to accurately measure growth of student learning, the data presented in this report will include all three PM windows. Comparing PM1 to PM3 provides educators and parents with a summative measure of student mastery of grade-level content and reflects standards-based learning growth across the school year. The present report provides a high-level summary of the performance data in comparison with similar school districts and the state of Florida overall.

FAST ELA

- All grade levels registered increases from PM1 to PM3 with respect to the percent of students scoring at Level 3 or higher. Among Palm Beach students, the largest increase was noted at grade 3 (26 percentage point increase from 22% to 48%) and smallest at Grade 6 (6 percentage point increase from 39% to 45%).
- At PM3, Palm Beach students performed higher than Florida in grades 5 and 7 and was equal to the state in grades 4, 8, 9 and 10. Grades 3 and 6 scores trailed the State.

¹ These results are based on all students tested, and not on the group of students used in the calculation of school grades.

FAST Math

- All grade levels registered increases from PM1 to PM3 in the percent of students scoring Level 3 or higher. The largest increase was noted at Grade 4 (46 percentage point increase from 6% to 52%) and the smallest increase was at Grade 7 (28 percentage point increase from 8% to 36%).
- At PM3, Palm Beach students performed higher than the state in grades 5 and 8; and was equal to the state in grade 6. Grades 3, 4, and 7 scores trailed the State.

As the standards have changed for Algebra 1 and Geometry, no prior year comparisons are available.

BEST Algebra 1 and Geometry EOCs

- 49% of the Algebra 1 exam takers scored at Level 3 or higher.
- Palm Beach performed at 50% Level 3 or higher while the State performed at 49% in Geometry.

Standards have not changed for Science, Biology, Civics, or US History; therefore, prior year comparisons are available.

Statewide Science Assessment

- Performance in Grade 5 science increased by 7 percentage points for Palm Beach (from 44% to 51%) and 3 percentage points for Florida (48% to 51%).
- Grade 8 science performance decreased slightly for both Palm Beach (46%) and the state (44%) compared to FY22 (47% and 45%, respectively).

NGSSS End of Course Exams

- Performance on the Biology EOCs increased for both Palm Beach (64% from 62% in FY22) students and students statewide (63% from 60% in FY22).
- In Civics, performance decreased slightly for both Palm Beach (65% from 68% in FY22) and statewide (66% from 69% in FY22).
- Performance also decreased in US History for Palm Beach (62% from 66% in FY22) and statewide (63% from 65% in FY22).
