## District & Community

Lisle Community Unit School District 202 is a public, K-12 District located approximately 25 miles west of Chicago in DuPage County in the "high tech corridor." DuPage County is mostly a middle and upper-middle class residential suburban area. In addition to Lisle High School, the District consists of one elementary school and one junior high.

## About Lisle High School

Lisle High School is a four-year (9-12) comprehensive high school with 49 certified staff members, 94% of those holding a Master's degree, and 2% with a Doctorate degree. The school day consists of seven 50-minute periods. All classes meet 5 days per week during two 18-week semesters, and each student is required to enroll in a minimum of 6 classes.

Lisle High School is accredited by the Illinois State Board of Education and the North Central Association of Colleges and Secondary Schools. The school was ranked in the top 10% of high schools in the state and the top 10% in the nation by *U.S. News & World Report* in 2023.

## Curriculum

Lisle High School offers a wide range of academic courses in order to challenge each student to achieve his or her potential. In addition, Lisle is a member of the Technology Center of DuPage, where students may select from an additional 19 hands-on occupational skill programs.
