October was National Principals Month, so we took a moment to thank our six amazing principals. We appreciate the hard work that you all put in for our TUHSD family.


We also thanked **Principal Brown** for all that he does for our Marcos de Niza family.








#### Coach of the Year




#### National Hispanic Recognition Award


Have questions? Drop by our film lab in room 121 during lunch or after school to meet with Ms. Ski and the Padre TV crew.

MDN Theatre's Fall Play


You Can't Take it With You

Congratulations to all these amazing students and staff! Thank you parents for your encouragement to students to reach their potential. The monthly winners are awarded with a certificate and luncheon.



The MdN Dual Language students visited Kyrene del Norte Elementary School and sang Spanish holiday songs and did fun activities with the younger students on December 7th.























#### ATHLETICS - Football
